**DECLARATION OF LOCAL DISASTER
BY
PROCLAMATION OF THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF FULSHEAR**

WHEREAS, I, Aaron Groff, Mayor of the City of Fulshear, issued a proclamation declaring a local disaster on February 18, 2021, certifying that Winter Storm Uri posed an imminent threat of widespread or severe damage, injury, or loss of life and property; and,

WHEREAS, the disaster declaration of February 18, 2021, expired on February 25, 2021; and,

WHEREAS, due to the catastrophic damage caused by Winter Storm Uri, a state of disaster continues to exist in the City of Fulshear; and,

WHEREAS, on March 16, 2021, the City Council of the City of Fulshear adopted Resolution No. 2021-508, consenting to the continuation or renewal of the February 18, 2021, disaster declaration for a period ending on April 30, 2021; and

WHEREAS, I find that suspension of certain regulatory provisions of the City of Fulshear is necessary because strict compliance with such provisions would prevent, hinder, or delay necessary action in coping with the disaster;

NOW THEREFORE, I, PRESIDING OFFICER OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FULSHEAR, HEREBY PROCLAIM AND DECLARE:

SECTION 1. That the disaster declared for the City of Fulshear on February 18, 2021, is hereby renewed.

SECTION 2. That this proclamation renewing the February 18, 2021, disaster declaration shall be in effect until 11:59 P.M. on April 30, 2021, unless earlier terminated, modified, or amended.

SECTION 3. That the regulatory provisions of Article II of Chapter 28 of the Fulshear Code are hereby suspended to the extent necessary to allow the owner or operator of any restaurant lawfully operating under a certificate of occupancy issued on or before February 18, 2021, to operate a mobile food unit on the premises of the restaurant, provided that:

- (1) all applicable provisions of Chapter 437, Texas Health and Safety Code, are complied with; and
- (2) all necessary Fort Bend County permits and approvals are obtained.

SECTION 4. All City of Fulshear permit and fee requirements applicable to a mobile food unit described by Section 3 hereof are hereby suspended.

SECTION 5. That this declaration shall be filed promptly with the City Secretary, and shall be given prompt and general publicity.

SECTION 6. That this proclamation shall take effect immediately from and after its issuance.
