A SPECIAL CITY COUNCIL MEETING WAS CALLED TO ORDER BY MAYOR JEFF W. ROBERTS, SUNDAY, SEPTEMBER 24, 2017 AT 5:35 P.M. IN THE CITY HALL LOCATED AT 30603 FM 1093 RD., FULSHEAR, TEXAS 77441 AND ALL CITIZENS WERE WELCOMED.

MAYOR ROBERTS ANNOUNCED THAT A QUORUM WAS PRESENT AND THAT MAYOR PROTEM KRENEK SHOULD BE HERE SHORTLY.

III. WORKSHOP ITEM

A. DISCUSSION OF FY 2018 CITY OF FULSHEAR OPERATING BUDGETS

C.J. SNIPES, CITY MANAGER, RECAPPED THE LAST DISCUSSION REGARDING THE BUDGET CHANGES. WES VELA, CHIEF FINANCE OFFICER, PROVIDED A HAND-OUT TO THE COUNCIL REGARDING REVISED BUDGET CHANGES. MAYOR PRO TEM KRENEK ASKED IF THESE WERE THE ITEMS SENT TO THE DROP BOX. MR. SNIPES STATED "YES".

C.J. SNIPES, CITY MANAGER, PROVIDED WHERE THE CUTS WOULD TAKE PLACE AND THE AMOUNT OF SAVINGS IN EACH CATEGORY. MAYOR ROBERTS STATED HE CONTINUES TO PUSH FOR A BALANCE BUDGET AND REQUEST STAFF TO LOOK AT OTHER AREAS. MAYOR PRO TEM KRENEK STATED SHE WAS SATISFIED WITH THE NEW PROPOSED FIGURES AND WAS COMFORTABLE IF THE FUND HAD TO BE DIPPED INTO FOR AN EXTRA \$250, 000.00. MAYOR PRO TEM KRENEK REQUESTED FOR THE MAYOR TO DESCRIBE TO THE COUNCIL WHAT A BALANCE BUDGET LOOKED LIKE TO HIM. MAYOR ROBERTS STATED TO REDUCE THE NEW I.T. POSITION TO A HALF A YEAR AND LOOK AT POLICE DEPARTMENT NOT ADDING A NEW OFFICER.

COUNCIL MEMBER KAHLICH INQUIRED ABOUT WHAT IS BEING DONE WITH THE GENEROUS DONATION FROM D.R. HORTON. C.J. SNIPES RESPONDED.

THERE WAS APPROXIMATELY AN HOUR AND HALF DISCUSSION AMONG THE STAFF MEMBERS AND COUNCIL REGARDING 2017-2018 BUDGET WHERE THE CUTS MIGHT BE POSSIBLE. FOR ALL OF THE SPECIFICS, REQUEST A COPY OF THE TAPE RECORDING.

COUNCIL MEMBER KAHLICH THANKED EVERYONE FOR THEIR HARD WORK.

MAYOR ROBERTS REINTERATED THE IMPORTANCE OF SETTING GOALS AND EVERYONE WORKING TOGETHER TO ACHIEVE IT (REFERRING TO A BALANCED BUDGET). MAYOR ROBERTS EXPRESSED CONFIDENCE THAT WE WILL BE ABLE TO REACH OUR GOAL.
