## IV. PUBLIC HEARING – FY 2017-2018 BUDGET

This budget will raise more revenue from Property Taxes than last year's budget by an amount of \$345,705 which is an increase of 18.79% from last year's budget. The property tax revenue to be raised from new property added to the tax roll this year is \$201,993. Staff recommends Council adopt the Maintenance and Operation Tax Rate of \$0.158691/\$100
