The Grandin Energy site is located adjacent to Rogers Rd, north side. The property owner's of the tract have requested certain terms related to the dedication of the utility easement being dedicated to facilitate the City Council approved Capital Improvement Project - W18K & WW18E; a utility project extending and expanding the City's water and wastewater system north along FM 359.

The terms in summary are:

- 1. City to provide two Sanitary Sewer connections taps
- 2. City to provide two water connections taps
- 3. City to provide a fire hydrant located within easement granted by Grandin

Staff believe the requests are reasonable and equitable to both parties

## DEVELOPMENT AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF FULSHEAR, TEXAS, AND GRANDIN ENERGY, LLC

This **DEVELOPMENT AGREEMENT** (hereinafter referred to as the "Agreement") is made and entered as of the date on which the last party hereto executes this agreement (hereinafter referred to as the "Effective Date"), between the City of Fulshear, Texas, a Texas home-rule municipality (hereinafter referred to as "City"), and Grandin Energy, LLC, a domestic limited liability corporation (hereinafter referred to as "Developer").

### **RECITALS**

WHEREAS, Developer owns that certain 3.0866 acre tract of land conveyed to Grandin Energy, LLC under Fort Bend County Clerk's File Number (F.B.C.C.F. No.) 2018024224 (the "Property"); and

WHEREAS, the City desires to acquire a utility easement with temporary construction license across the Property in consideration of the terms set forth herein; and

WHEREAS, the Developer desires to grant a utility easement with temporary construction license across the Property in consideration of the terms set forth herein;

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the terms set forth herein and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, the City and Developer agree as follows:

### ARTICLE I PROVISIONS FOR THE DEVELOPER

Section 1.01 Waiver of Actions Under Private Real Property Rights Preservation Act. The Developer hereby waives its right, if any, to assert any causes of action against the City accruing under the Private Real Property Rights Preservation Act, Chapter 2007, Texas Government Code (the "Act") or other state law, that the City's execution or performance of this Agreement or any authorized amendment or supplements thereto may constitute, either now or in the future, a "Taking" of Developer's or its grantee's, or a grantee's successor's "Private Real Property," as such terms are defined in the Act. Provided, however, that this waiver does not apply to, and the Developer and its grantees and successors do not waive their rights under the Act to assert a claim under the Act for any action taken by the City beyond the scope of this Agreement which otherwise may give rise to a cause of action under the Act.

<u>Section 1.02 Ownership of Property</u>. Developer represents and warrants that it is the sole owner of fee simple title to the Property as of the effective date of this Agreement.

Section 1.03 Undocumented Workers. Developer certifies that Developer does not and will not knowingly employ an undocumented worker in accordance with Chapter 2264 of the Texas Government Code, as amended. If during the Term of this Agreement, Developer is convicted of a violation under 8 U.S.C. § 1324a(f), Developer shall repay the amount of any public subsidy

provided under this Agreement plus interest, at the rate of the prime rate plus six percent (6%) per annum, not later than the 120th day after the date the City notifies Developer of the violation.

Section 1.04 Anti-Boycott Verification. As required by Chapter 2271, Texas Government Code, Developer hereby verifies that it, including a wholly owned subsidiary, majority-owned subsidiary, parent company, or affiliate of the same, does not boycott Israel and will not boycott Israel through the term of this Agreement. The term "boycott Israel" in this paragraph has the meaning assigned to such term in Section 808.001 of the Texas Government Code, as amended.

Section 1.05 Iran, Sudan, and Foreign Terrorist Organizations. Pursuant to Chapter 2252, Texas Government Code, Developer hereby verifies that, at the time of execution of this Agreement neither it, nor any wholly owned subsidiary, majority-owned subsidiary, parent company, or affiliate of the same, is a company listed by the Texas Comptroller of Public Accounts under Sections 2270.0201 or 2252.153 of the Texas Government Code.

<u>Section 1.06 Utility Easement with Temporary Construction License</u>. The Developer agrees to grant to the City, on or before thirty (30) days after the Effective Date, a Utility Easement with Temporary Construction License upon a portion of the Property, in the form attached hereto as <u>Exhibit A</u> (the "Easement").

<u>Section 1.07 Impact Fees</u>. The Developer agrees and acknowledges that it shall be responsible for any impact fees applicable to the Property as may be imposed, assessed, and collected by the City as provided by law.

### ARTICLE II PROVISIONS FOR THE CITY

Section 2.01 Water Taps. Upon request of and at no cost to the Developer, the City agrees to connect no more than two (2) laterals ("Water Taps") to the water main to be constructed by the City within the Easement, provided that the size and location of such Water Taps is in accordance with sound engineering principles as determined by the City in its sole discretion, and further provided that such Water Taps shall be used solely for the purpose of providing water service to development within the Property.

<u>Section 2.02 Sewer Taps</u>. Upon request of and at no cost to the Developer, the City agrees to connect no more than two (2) laterals ("Sewer Taps") to the sewer main to be constructed by the City within the Easement, provided that the size and location of such Sewer Taps is in accordance with sound engineering principles as determined by the City in its sole discretion, and further provided that such Sewer Taps shall be used solely for the purpose of providing sewer service to development within the Property.

<u>Section 2.03 Additional Water and Sewer Taps</u>. Nothing herein shall prohibit the Developer from acquiring additional Water Taps, Sewer Taps, or both, at the sole cost and expense of the Developer, as may be permitted by applicable law.

<u>Section 2.04 Fire Hydrant</u>. Upon request of and at no cost to the Developer, the City agrees to install no more than one (1) fire hydrant within the Easement at a location agreeable to the Developer, provided that the location is in accordance with sound engineering principles and in

accordance with the City's applicable fire hydrant placement standards as determined by the City in its sole discretion.

### ARTICLE III BENEFICIARIES, TERM, ASSIGNMENT, AND AMENDMENT

Section 3.01 Beneficiaries. This Agreement shall bind and inure to the benefit of the City and the Developer, their successors and assigns.

<u>Section 3.02 Term.</u> This Agreement shall be effective from and on the Effective Date and shall terminate on the earlier of the full performance of each party's obligations as set forth herein or fifteen (15 year term) from the Effective Date.

<u>Section 3.03 Assignment.</u> This Agreement may not be assigned by either party without the express written consent of the other party, which consent may not be unreasonably withheld.

<u>Section 3.04 Amendment.</u> This Agreement may be amended only upon written amendment executed by the City and Developer.

### ARTICLE IV MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS

<u>Section 4.01 Applicable Law and Venue.</u> The construction and validity of this Agreement shall be governed by the laws of the State of Texas without regard to conflicts of law principles. Venue shall be in Fort Bend County, Texas.

<u>Section 4.02 Reservation of Rights.</u> To the extent not inconsistent with this Agreement, each party reserves all rights, privileges, and immunities under applicable laws, including sovereign immunity, except to enforce any rights and remedies under this Agreement.

<u>Section 4.03 Further Documents.</u> The parties agree that at any time after execution of this Agreement, they will, upon request of another party, execute and deliver such further documents and do such further acts and things as the other party may reasonably request in order to effectuate the terms of this Agreement.

Section 4.04 Incorporation of Exhibits and Other Documents by Reference. All Exhibits and other documents attached to or referred to in this Agreement are incorporated herein by reference for the purposes set forth in this Agreement.

Section 4.05 Effect of State and Federal Laws. Notwithstanding any other provision of this Agreement, Developer and its successors and assigns and the City and its successors and assigns, shall comply with all applicable statutes or regulations of the United States and the State of Texas, as well as any applicable City ordinances to the extent not in conflict with this Agreement, and any rules implementing such statutes or regulations. This section may not be interpreted to extend to the Property those City ordinances which are not applicable to the extraterritorial jurisdiction of the City.

Section 4.06 Authority for Execution. The City hereby certifies, represents, and warrants that the execution of this Agreement is duly authorized and adopted in conformity with the City charter and ordinances. The Developer hereby certifies, represents, and warrants that the execution of this Agreement is duly authorized and adopted in conformity with the articles of incorporation and bylaws or partnership agreements of such entities, as applicable.

<u>Section 4.07 Caption Headings.</u> Caption headings in this Agreement are for convenience purposes only and are not to be used to interpret or define the provisions of the Agreement.

<u>Section 4.08 Counterparts</u>. This Agreement may be executed in one or more counterparts, each of which shall be deemed an original and all of which shall constitute one and the same document.IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the undersigned parties have executed this Agreement to be effective as of the Effective Date.



### **EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**

The City Council adopted the FY 20 Capital Improvement Program (CIP) Projects budget to include related to Drainage, Streets, Facilities, Parks, & Utilities.

The COVID-19 event affected the City's ability to effectively begin/implement some of these projects. In addition, a Project Manager position, approved by City Council to fill in FY 21 at mid-year, began in February, with interviews scheduled in March. The timing of the event preempted our interview process, delaying the fulfillment of the position until a later date.

With the uncertainty of the duration of the event, staff have reviewed the CIP to determine which projects are waiting to begin design and/or construction.

The following projects that fall into that category, have General Fund (GF) and CIP funding Staff are presenting them here for City council discussion and possible guidance on advancement/delay:

- 1. D18A Master Drainage Plan (\$75,000) (CIP Funds) (Need to assign to Professional Services Vendor)
- 2. D18B Drainage System Mgt Program (\$100,000) (CIP Funds) (Designed/ready for bid in 30-60 days 5 months for construction)
- 3. D20B Downtown East Side Storm Sewer (\$1,000,000) (80% GF;20% EDC) (Need RFQ for design; bid for construction)
- 4. ST20E Redbird Ln Project (\$500,000) (GF)(Need to assign a Professional Services vendor for design; bid for construction)
