

Public Hearing

In compliance with the City of Fulshear Zoning Ordinance and Chapter 211 of the Local Government Code, the City will hold two Public Hearings regarding a proposed zoning map amendment for an approximately 6.138 acre tract of land located at 7355 Farm-to-Market 359 S Fulshear, Texas 77441. The tract of land, currently vacant, and currently zoned General Commercial requests to be zoned into the “Industrial” (3.716 acres) and “Downtown District” (2.422 acres) zoning districts.
