#### **EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**

At the regularly scheduled, January 4, 2019 Planning and Zoning meeting, the Planning and Zoning Commission had for its consideration the plats for:

- 1. Preliminary Plat Dewberry Acres
- 2. Preliminary Plat Lamar CISD Tamarron Elementary School
- 3. Preliminary Plat Tamarron Multifamily
- 4. Preliminary Plat Fulbrook on Fulshear Creek Section 14
- 5. Final Plat Tamarron Crossing Section 3- Street Dedication
- 6. Final Plat Tamarron Section 13

The plats, as submitted for consideration, generally meet the requirements set forth in the City's Subdivision Ordinance No. 04-913 and/or 013-1091, which is in alignment with Chapter 21, Texas Local Government Code. Plat comments noted in the City Engineer's report are provided in support of the rules and regulations governing plats and subdivisions of land within the City's territorial limits and the extra territorial jurisdiction to promote safe, orderly, and healthful development of the City.

The Preliminary and Final Plats submitted for consideration were reviewed by the City Engineer. Comments were sent to the applicants and asked to address all comments prior to the January 4<sup>th</sup> Planning and Zoning Commission meeting. All comments were addressed to the City Engineer's satisfaction. Note: Dewberry Acres, a small 4 lot plat will is proposed as a private subdivision accessing of Katy Fulshear Road in the City's ETJ, LCISD Tamarron Elementary is aware and is in the process of completing a Traffic Impact Analysis which will need to be submitted to staff for review prior to final plat, Tamarron Multifamily will need an updated Traffic Impact Analysis and Drainage Plan prior to final plat, and Fulbrook on Fulshear Creek Section 14 has a street name, Sweet Dewberry Ln, that will need renaming prior to final plat approval.

The Planning and Zoning Commission is forwarding positive approvals for all plats submitted with the comments noted.

Staff recommends City Council approve the follow plats:

- 1. Preliminary Plats for: Dewberry Acres, Lamar CISD Tamarron Elementary School, Tamarron Multifamily, and Fulbrook on Fulshear Creek Section 14

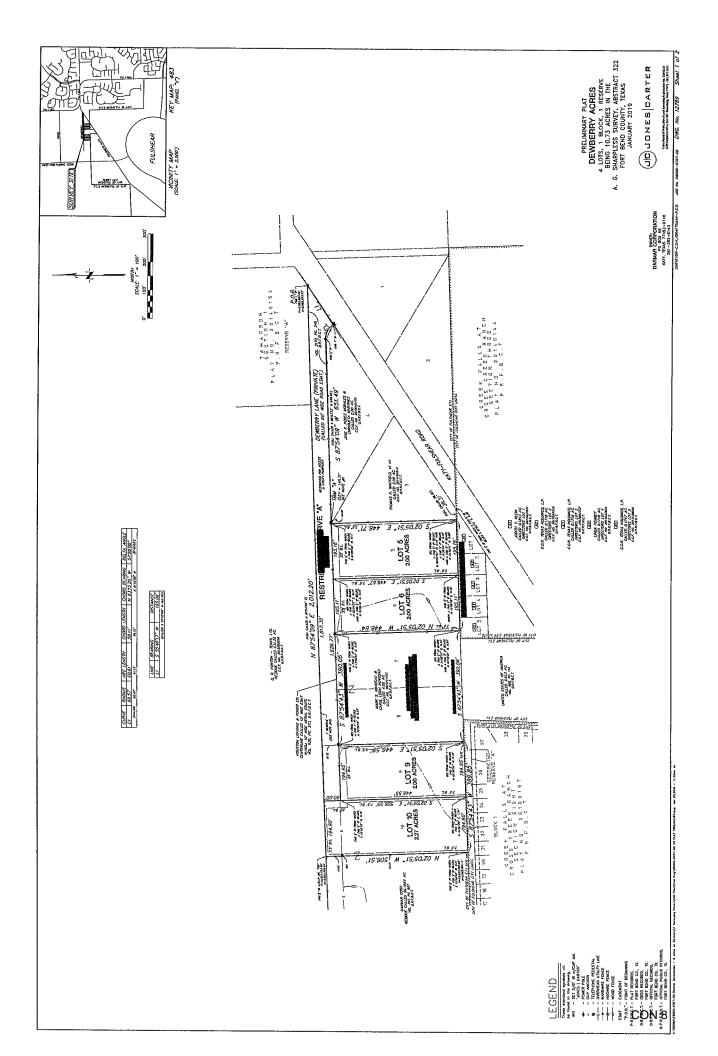
### For Information Only:

- 1. This plat will create four (4) Lots that were part of an older subdivision that was sold by Metes & Bounds and never was platted. It will also create one (1) Restricted Reserve "A" which covers an existing Private Road.
- 2. All four of the Lots are 2.00 acres or more in size and have access to Dewberry Lane (Private) from Katy-Fulshear Road.
- 3. Since this tract is located in the ETJ of the City of Fulshear approval will be needed from the City and Fort Bend County, Texas.

#### Recommendations:

I recommend that this Preliminary Plat of Dewberry Acres be approved once the following items have been addressed:

- A) This plat will require a variance to allow Dewberry Lane to remain a Private Road.
- B) Restricted Reserve "A" needs to extend West thru Lot 10 to provide access to the Darmar Residue.
- C) Lot 10 will also need a 25-foot Front Building Line.

Attached you will find the General Fund and the two Utility Fund monthly financial reports for the period ended **December 31, 2018**. This report represents the activity for **three (3)** unaudited **months** or **25**% of the fiscal year. For the General Fund the total revenues are reported at **37.16**% of budget and total expenditures are reported at **17.48**% which both are in line with expectations. In the Utility Funds revenues are **11.78**% and **14.69**% for the City of Fulshear Utility (COF) and Cross Creek Ranch Utility (CCR) Funds respectively. Service revenue in each utility fund is not recorded until billed therefore for example; October's utility revenues are not billed until early November. Expenditures are at **23.89**% of budget for the COF Utility and **14.69**% for the CCR Utility.

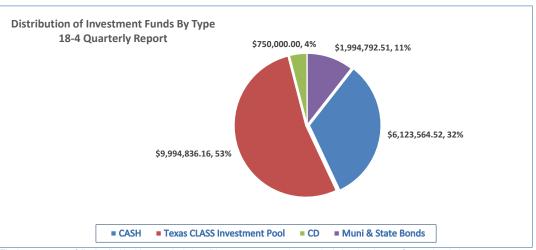
