EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The City of Fulshear's former City Hall facility site at 30603 FM 1093 is a 2.215 acre tract or parcel of land. Previous discussions with City Council indicate Council desires to provide for the sale of the 2.215 acre tract.

Ordinance 2021-1353 is presented for consideration providing for the following:

- 1. City Manager is directed to sell and convey the 2.215 acre tract
- 2. Sell to be in accordance with applicable laws, but not limited to public auction, sealed bid or under a broker agreement approved by City Council
- 3. City Manager directed to take any action and execute any instrument necessary or incidental to complete the sale.
- 4. City Manager may not accept an offer and may not sell at a price less than \$1,500,000.

RECOMMENDATION

City Council approve and adopt Ordinance 2021-1353 directing the City Manager to sell the 2.215 acre tract located at 30603 FM 1093, the site of the former City Hall facility.

ORDINANCE NO. 2021-1353

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF FULSHEAR, TEXAS, DIRECTING THE CITY MANAGER TO SELL AND CONVEY CERTAIN LAND THAT THE CITY OWNS, BEING THE SITE FOR THE FORMER CITY HALL AND BEING MORE PARTICULARLY DESCRIBED HEREIN; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR REPEAL AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, on June 18, 2021, the City of Fulshear, Texas (the "City"), purchased that certain 3.781 acre tract or parcel of land described by deed recorded as county clerk file number 2021102753 in the real property records of Fort Bend County, Texas, as a site for a new City Hall; and

WHEREAS, the City also owns that certain approximately 2.215 acre tract or parcel of land located at 30603 FM 1093, being the site of the former City Hall; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to direct the City Manager to execute the conveyance of the site of the former City Hall, subject to certain limitations or conditions as provided for herein;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FULSHEAR, TEXAS:

- <u>Section 1</u>. (a) Subject to subsection (b), the City Manager of the City of Fulshear, Texas, is hereby directed to sell and convey that certain approximately 2.215 acre tract or parcel of land located at 30603 FM 1093, being the site of the former City Hall, by any manner authorized by law, including but not limited to public auction, sealed bid, or under a broker agreement approved by the City Council, and to take any action and execute any instrument necessary or incidental to effect such sale and conveyance.
- (b) The City manager may not accept an offer and may not sell and convey the land described in subsection (a) for a sales price less than ONE MILLION FIVE-HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$1,500,000.00).
- <u>Section 2</u>. <u>Severability</u>. In the event any clause, phrase, provision, sentence or part of this Ordinance or the application of the same to any person or circumstances shall for any reason be adjudged invalid or held unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, it shall not affect, impair or invalidate this Ordinance as a whole or any part or provision hereof other than the part declared to be invalid or unconstitutional; and the City Council of the City of Fulshear, Texas declares that it would have passed each and every part of the same notwithstanding the omission of any part thus declared to be invalid or unconstitutional, or whether there be one or more parts.

Section 3. Repeal. All other ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent or in conflict herewith are, to the extent of such inconsistency or conflict, hereby repealed.
Section 4. Effective date. This Ordinance shall be effective and in full force when published as required by law.
