CDC MEMBER BRYAN WHITE STATED SINCE THE SPLIT OF THE EDC BOARDS THERE IS NO COUNCIL LIASON FOR CDC. MAYOR GROFF STATED CDC DOES NOT ALLOW A COUNCIL MEMBER TO BE A LIASON THAT A COMMUNITY MEMBER WOULD NEED TO ATTEND.
