- CONCRETE HAS BEEN PLACED FOR THE GROUND STORAGE TANK (GST) 16" OUTLET PIPE, 12" DRAINPIPE AND INLET/FUTURE INLET PIPES; GEO-TEXTILE FABRIC HAS BEEN PLACED AND 57 STONE INSTALLED AND COMPACTED FOR TANK FOUNDATION
